

THE CONTINGENT PROCESS

The process of creating a film consists of three phases: Pre-Production, Production and Post-Production. The process is the same for all our services.

- Initial meeting 10- 20 minutes over the phone discussion or face to face.
- > **Phase one** (Pre-Production) is where all the planning and coordination happens.
- > Phase two (Production) when we capture all of the elements for your video.
- Phase three (Post-Production) when all elements are edited together, and combined to create the final video.

The Quotation Process

Our Rates:

- \$650/day per person for work in the field such as, cinematographer, sound recordist, drone operator. This rate is inclusive of equipment.
- \$550/day per person for behind the scenes work including writing, producing and editing.

After we receive the initial brief our producer estimates the following:

- how many days are required for filming
- how many crew members are required
- how many days it will be in edit

Based on your brief, the producer will assess how many days and creatives will be required. If the quote doesn't match your budget, we can amend the scope and explore less expensive options. It always helps to know your budget, or at least a ball-park idea so that the producer can adapt the concept to the budget and allocate time for creatives and crew accordingly.

Below is how we allocate time on your production for each phase of production:

PRE-PRODUCTION

Account management - Drafting scripts -Treatment writing - Script approvals - Shoot scheduling - Castings - Recces

PRODUCTION

Filming - Audio recording - Aerial cinematography - Directing talent

POST-PRODUCTION

Assembly edits - First cut - Feedback and changes - Final sign off - Picture lock -Colour grade - Audio mastering - Delivery
