Dr Tracey Thornton, Owner/Veterinarian Heartlands Veterinary Hospital Heartlands Veterinary Hospital in York is a mixed-practice veterinary hospital servicing the Avon Valley and surrounding areas.

They engaged QDS to support the design of a purpose-built, innovative and energy-efficient veterinary hospital that would better serve the needs of their patients, clients and their team.

The facility required a reception/waiting area, several consulting rooms, a pharmacy, a large treatment area, an imaging (radiology) room as well as several wards for the patients and staff amenities, and a separate operating theatre - all to fit into a 500m2 building.

QDS was delighted to assist, however the engagement presented a number of challenges for everyone involved:

- 1. The location was in a rural area which meant builders had to be locally sourced or be prepared to travel to the area.
- 2. The building was heritage listed which required additional considerations in design and build and significant council liaison.
- 3. Due to strict regulations associated with safe and hygienic veterinary clinics, design requirements and build considerations were very specific and inflexible.

QDS worked closely with the client throughout the entire process, contributing more than 300hours into issue resolution and design. QDS further supported the client by helping with the construction tender process and finding a suitable builder, as well as being involved during the construction to make sure the client's vision was met.

The result was a state-of-the-art veterinary clinic which is loved by staff, clients, and community alike.







QDS was engaged by Rapid Tilt Construction to design and project manage the consultants of a shopping centre in Maida Vale. The centre was to include eight units: an IGA, cafe, restaurant, bottle shop, two offices, medical centre and a pharmacy. Concept designs were completed for the café, restaurant, bottle shop, medical centre and pharmacy. Construction plans were completed for the IGA and two offices.

Design and documentation for this shopping centre took more than two years, due to council approvals and external consultants misinterpreting the client's requirements and budget.

QDS worked closely with the council to address their concerns and engaged a Town Planner to submit a Joint Development Assessment Panel (JDAP) application and subseguently we received development approval.

This process required significant design changes and continual communication and stakeholder engagement to design and construct a solution which more accurately reflected the client's requirments and budget.

With our support, QDS's client, Rapid Tilt Construction, was awarded the contract to build the development, and the owner who runs the IGA finally opened his store in early 2022.


